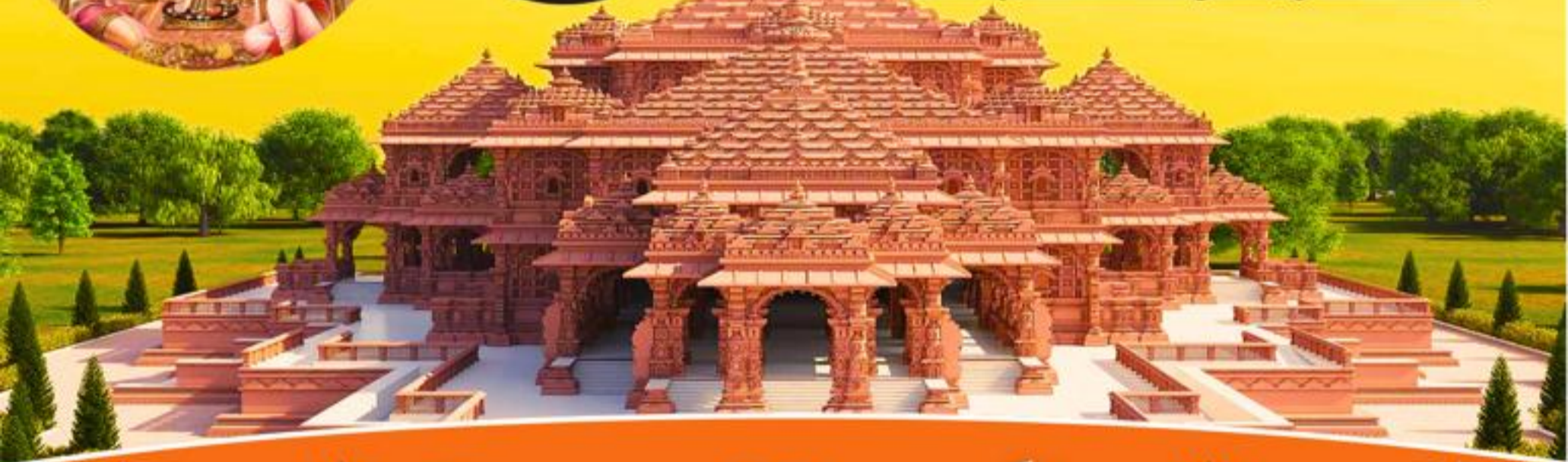

(Please note there is a slight schedule change from the previous announcement. The Cultural program will start at 4:00 P.M. instead of 4:30 P.M. So the first bus from Corporate Woods start around 3:45 P.M.)

Dear Devotees

Due to the planned fireworks, parking availability at the temple is very limited in the afternoon of January 21, 2024, for the Cultural program and Shri Rama Pattabhishekam. Few parking spaces will be made available for senior citizens on first-come basis.

Devotees can park their vehicles in the parking lots 12,14,16 and 18 in Corporate Woods. HTS is organizing two Durham school buses to shuttle the devotees between Corporate Woods and the Temple. The first shuttle from Corporate Woods will start around 3:45 P.M.

Devotees can also drop their family members off at the Temple before parking their vehicles at Corporate Woods and use the shuttle service from Corporate Woods to the Temple. There will be volunteers at the Temple to guide the devotees. The last bus from the Temple to the Corporate Woods will be at around 10:30 P.M.

HTS is thankful to Town of Colonie Police department for providing patrolling services around the temple from the night of January 20 through January 21 morning during the Akhand Ramayan Path, and in the evening of January 21 during the Cultural program and Fireworks.
