Note on filing nomination

Nominations could be filed in one of 2 ways.

- 1) Nominations could be handed over in person to a NEC member who will be present at the temple at specific times mentioned in NEC bulletin 1.
- 2) Scanned nominations could be emailed to the NEC member at HTSNEC2024@gmail.com.

Please note that nominations can <u>no longer be dropped in the Hundi</u> as was the practice in past years. The nomination form has to be filled in completely to avoid any confusion.

Election Process

Elections will be conducted consistent with Article 6 of the constitution. Given the learnings during the past few elections the following guidelines will be adopted.

Term of Office: Members will be elected only for such term that fulfils Article 6, Section 7 of the Constitution.

Tie: In case of a tie, a flip of a coin by the EAC Chairman will determine the winner.

Absentee Ballots: Every effort will be made to ensure return of absentee ballots. However, if the completed absentee ballots are not returned on time by the members, NEC has no option but to assume that requestor has not returned the ballot.
